- One full academic year of transcripts with minimum 3.5 GPA
- Application essays that display technical skill and intellectual depth
- Strong letters of recommendation
- A variety of extracurricular interests

#### Penn Summer Prep Program

July 5 - July 19, 2025



Residential, non-credit program



Eligibility: Current 9th-11th grade students



Scholarship opportunity for select Philadelphia students

The two-week program offers non-credit, on-campus, immersive study in disciplines across the sciences, arts, and humanities. Students choose two modules to focus their studies and benefit from the University's rich educational resources. International students must secure the necessary tourist or B-2 visa from their home country.



#### **Online Seminars**

Session 1: June 9 - June 27, 2025 Session 2: July 7 - July 25, 2025



Fully online, non-credit program



Eligibility: Current 9th-11th grade students

Online Seminars are three-week, subject-intensive online learning experiences and can include virtual labs or journal clubs. Seminars will consist of 15 hours of activity per week (live online and asynchronous sessions, readings, project work) with at least 3 hours weekly of live Zoom sessions. No visa is needed for any program running entirely online.



### Pre-College Online Program

Session I, fully online: May 27 - July 2, 2025 Session II, fully online: July 3 - August 8, 2025

**Eligibility: Current 10th-11th grade students** 

The Pre-College Online Program offers six-week undergraduate courses in a wide array of disciplines taught by Penn faculty, staff, and visiting scholars. Students can enroll from anywhere in the world and take courses online alongside Penn undergraduates. No visa is needed for any program running entirely online.
