Pioneer-Plus Scholarship 2025

The Pioneer-Plus Scholarship is available to qualified Conestoga High School graduates after the conclusion of at least one successful year at a technical/trade school, a community college, or a 4-year college, to help cover the costs of the following year's tuition/room/board. All applicants must be well-rounded students who are committed to working hard in their schooling while also making good decisions in their everyday lives. Scholarship amounts vary, but they tend to be in the \$1000-\$3000 range. No student can apply more than 3 times for this assistance. To qualify for this award, the applicant must meet the requirements below:

- Earn a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 freshman year, and 3.0 subsequent years
- Participate in at least one sports team, club or other activity while on campus
- Hold at least a part time job while on campus and during the summer
- Exhibit a need for financial assistance by having received grants from all possible financial aid sources, including FAFSA & Pell (and PHEAA if at a PA school)
- Have a clean record of suspensions or disciplinary action during the previous year in college

Qualified applicants should complete the form below and submit it to the CHS by <u>July 15</u>. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
