

DO YOU NEED HELP COVERING THE COST OF SCHOOL LUNCHES?

Tredyffrin & Easttown Care is a local non-profit that helps families in our community in a variety of ways when emergencies occur or situations become complicated. T&E Care recognizes that school meals can be difficult for some families to afford on a regular basis, especially if their income is just over the Free/Reduced Program's limits. T&E Care has a program that can provide a limited subsidy for these expenses for qualifying students.

WHO QUALIFIES?

You must <u>FIRST</u> apply for participation in the Free/Reduced Program run through the school district. If you are accepted into that program – that's great – it's better than ours. But if you are denied – then you can apply for the T&E Care program. Students will be eligible based on household income (see application for income guidelines). The T&E Care program is designed to be a transition for families making just too much money to qualify for free/reduced assistance.



HOW DOES MY CHILD GET THE FUNDING?

Each month qualified students will get deposits automatically into their point-of-sale accounts. The amount deposited will depend on the students' grade level. The funding source for your child's money is confidential.
